We are extremely proud of our young leaders: madrichim and madrachot, who stay on after bar/bat mitzvah to become young educators working as part of our multi-skilled team.

We offer our own bespoke training programme, which covers our ethos, teamwork, teaching skills and safeguarding. Some of our leaders choose to stay on as volunteers teaching on Friday evenings, or Sunday mornings, and others progress with us over a number of years to a paid role.

Very many of your young people stay until they leave home for university. This role is voluntary, and so popular that we always have a large team every year, who work one to one, or in small classes, teaching the next generation.

We also encourage our young people to get involved in RSY Netzer, our national youth movement. This year, six of our post GCSE year 11s joined the Tour to Jewish Europe, and two of our members are leaders on residential summer camp.
