



RELIGION SCHOOL

Our Religion School is small and beautiful. With nearly 100% attendance every week, we think our children are voting with their feet and love coming here. We believe that a Religion School that is warm, creative and ambitious is vital for the children of our community to develop a positive Jewish identity. We believe it must be fun, different from ordinary school, and at the same time offer our children a solid curriculum where they can build deep Jewish knowledge as well as strong Hebrew reading skills. Friendships are also very important. Many of our families have one Jewish and one non-Jewish parents, and everyone is taught to respect and celebrate our cultures.

We offer a welcoming and engaging learning environment, with a curriculum that supports children from Reception through to Year 6. Pupils explore the Hebrew Bible (Torah), festivals, Jewish life, and Reform Jewish values in a way that is meaningful and relevant. We also provide a positive and thoughtful space for learning about Israel. Alongside this, we place a strong emphasis on developing confident Hebrew reading skills, supported by the Eizeh Kef Hebrew teaching programme.

Each week includes a 'Creative' choice session, where children can explore different activities and interests. Through music, dance, drama, arts and crafts, storytelling, outdoor experiences, and cookery, themes are brought to life in imaginative ways. These sessions encourage deeper learning while helping children build connections with one another.

All children progress on to our B'nei Mitzvah Programme in year 7, and most become young educators/madrachim.

Our team includes qualified and experienced teaching staff, madrichim and madrachot (teenage young educators) and our rabbi.
